- Fall Convention conversations:

  - Talked with other program chairs regarding strategies to get people to stay at Convention throughout whole time: One Convention chair states they need to go to 6/8 sessions offered.
  - Talked with other program chairs to see how they efficiently vet and book sessions. Based on these discussions, I would like to set up a better way to have board members help with vetting, but I'm not yet sure how this could look.
- I was supposed to go to PDAC but I was ill.

#### Ideas:

**1. Hosting an in person vetting session with volunteer board members at the end of July.** This would have to happen after the website link closes. I would want to have proposals printed and pre-organized to give to volunteers to pick best ones out of the topics they feel like they have experience with. It would be a full day. It would start with being "Trained" on things to look for before making decisions.

**Objective:** Better vetting and programming choices in a more timely manner: one day verses all summer.

**2. a. Provide detailed information to each board member for how to submit sessions** so they have better information to provide people on how to submit sessions.

**2. b. Put specific volunteers in charge of contacting and communicating with people** where there may be holes in the program (based on their contacts and expertise).

**Objective:** A collective responsibility with finding speakers where there may be holes in the program.
